This program is aimed to find forever families for orphans and children in institutional care.


Despite all the challenges of wartime, our "Family Mentoring" program was actively implemented in 2023.

As a result 144 orphans and children deprived of parental care were placed in families.

At the Mentoring Association, we give teenagers a voice and a choice. During our meetings, tours and various program events, children get to know their mentors in a friendly, relaxed atmosphere. Thanks to this, they begin to open up and build a trusting relationship with their significant adult mentor.

Our specialists constantly support the mentor-mentee pairs formed through the program, and provide psychological assistance upon request from children and mentors.



During 2023 we conducted **972 individual communications** and **62 psychological sessions** for children and youth which helped to resolve urgent situations, respond to their needs in a timely manner, and support their emotional and psychological well-being.

TRAINING OF MENTORS

Interest in mentoring in Ukraine continues to increase. More and more people are willing to become a mentor for a vulnerable child.

Mentoring Association has conducted **12 orientation meetings** for **64 people** from various regions of Ukraine.
At these meetings, our trainer and psychologist provide detailed information on how to become a mentor and answers questions from the audience. We conducted **30 individual interviews** with people who would like to become an individual mentor.

Sonya and Elena

Why mentoring? Because it changes lives...

Sonya and Elena are a bright example of how support and understanding change lives. Elena, through her sincerity and care, constantly supported Sonia, helping her to understand herself and inspiring her to believe in her own strengths and capabilities. The girl went through many difficult moments and challenges in her life, but thanks to her wise mentor, she found the strength to discover herself.



Today, Sonya is a student of graphic design school, and her talent in drawing is a reflection of her rich inner world. The achievements in her life became possible with the Corporate Mentoring program, which gave her the opportunity to take piercing courses and work in the field she really likes.

The most important thing is that Sonya has become an openminded and positive person who believes in herself. The girl explores the world by drawing it with her own hands and believes that she can achieve anything she sets her mind to.



«Elena and I communicate openly, we can discuss almost anything. It is important to me that we show our true selves. I love our communication. I get support from Elena, sometimes I can support her, and I like it very much» — Sonya.


Nastya's story

Nastya came to the program with a heavy burden of the past and a lack of self-confidence. While in the rehabilitation center, she was shy about establishing contacts and making acquaintances, although she really wanted to do some useful things. Participation in the program dramatically changed the girl's life, she turned into a real leader with an active social position.





«For me, the Corporate Mentoring program means friendship, communication, new acquaintances and opportunities. It has provided me with reliable people and new perspectives. Through mentoring, I discovered my hidden talents and was able to progress in chosen field. I studied to be a social worker and did an internship at the Mentoring Association. This activity allowed me to understand many positive aspects and details, as well as made me realize the importance of continuous development in my profession. In addition, I found a mentor who helped me find my own path and overcome difficult moments in my life» — Nastya, 18 years old.



Currently, she works as a barista and continues to help others. But this is only the beginning of her dream. Nastya wants to do more — to provide support and inspire hope in children who have lost their parents. Her strong will and belief in herself helped her become vivid proof that even with a difficult past, you can find your pathway to success and a happy future.









In 2023 we have launched our joint **project «Taking Flight** with Boeing», which is already showing significant results.

The project currently involves more than **40 company specialists** who have chosen a role that is comfortable for them: volunteer, lecturer, mentor, or specialist who conducts workshops. The specialists also take part in open events with their families.

About 100 children from 8 regions of Ukraine have already participated in the project. And more participants keep joining. «It was a lot of fun.

In the near future, in this safe place orphans and children deprived of parental care will be introduced to loving and caring families and our youth will have a wonderful opportunity for internship.

The participants of the Path to Success program and their mentors spent time outdoors in **SKVO Space**, a real oasis in Kyiv where you forget your worries, where you can restore and be inspired. While working together, everyone communicated, joked, got to know each other better and built friendly, trusting relationships.

Courses

The courses organized by the Association's partners allow teenagers to get acquainted with various interesting professions and help them choose their own path in the future. Studying under the guidance of mentors in the profession builds their confidence in their own abilities. Mentors not only impart technical knowledge about the profession, but also teach important life values, including communication skills and the development of creative thinking, determination, providing teenagers with new opportunities for selfdevelopment, the implementation of their own ideas and successful implementation in their independent lives.

Sport promotes physical and psychological health, increases selfesteem and confidence, teaches teamwork and strategic thinking. For orphans, mentoring in sports becomes a source of support, discipline and positive life values.

PROGRAM • SUPERMENTORS

We launched a pilot project, the **Supermentors Leadership Club**, with young people who have completed the Corporate Mentoring program.

Their goal is to become real leaders, create change in our country and influence important processes to improve the lives of children who, like them, are in difficult life circumstances.



Each project participant will have the opportunity to communicate with successful people, learn leadership skills from them, and practice the acquired skills on a peer-to-peer basis.

As a result of the two-day leadership training, a strategy was developed for the club's further advancement. The youth identified key areas they would like to work on. The future leaders generated their own ideas for the development of social and business initiatives to be implemented in this project.



PROGRAM • PARTNERSHIP





Based on the best professional practices of Israeli psychologists in psycho-social support and traumafocused care before, during and after war and emergencies, our certified specialists have developed the Self-Help First Aid Kit training in Ukrainian and English, which has been effectively used to work with children and adolescents, as well as with mentors, partner NGOs and business specialists.

SELF-HELP TRAUMA INFORMED TRAINING

In cooperation with the **Israeli Trauma Coalition**, a training was held on "Providing first aid, self-help and reducing burnout and fatigue syndrome while helping others."

Fifteen specialists from different regions of Ukraine who work with children and vulnerable population, including IDPs, received certificates after completion 24 hours of training.



PROGRAM • PARTNERSHIP



PUBLIC SECTOR

We are in constant communication with the Kyiv City Center of Social Services and the Service for Children and Families of the Kyiv City State Administration on joint actions for the benefit of children. We also communicate with the KCSA Social Dormitory for Boys, the Center for Social and Psychological Rehabilitation of Children #1, the Specialized Boarding School #21, the Transport Lyceum, and the Interregional Center for Jewelry Art.

COOPERATION WITH NGOs

A conference in Kamianets-Podilskyi on the role of non-profit organizations (NGOs) in protecting children's rights, where our specialists and young people from the Corporate Mentoring program were speakers, welcomed more than 70 volunteers and organizations that help children stay out of boarding schools and help them with family placement.



The conference brought together volunteers and organizations from 12 regions of **Ukraine** to share experiences and tools to improve the quality of care for vulnerable children. The Mentoring Association shared its experience in solving the problem of children from institutionalized facilities and spoke about the importance of building effective communication with the public sector.



The training course for trainers

to become candidates for individual mentors was attended by 16 participants from 7 cities of Ukraine. The results of this course will serve as a basis for further expansion of the certified coaching team for the development of mentoring in Ukraine.



PROGRAM • PARTNERSHIP



As part of our cooperation with the Better Future Foundation, our team held an informational and motivational meeting in Khmelnytsky for those who wanted to become a mentor or foster family for children from orphanages and boarding schools. Our specialists also shared effective tools for providing support to children in institutional care.



The US non-profit organization KIDSAVE

is co-founder of Mentoring Association and grants the Association a license to implement, train and distribute its programs in Ukraine, as well as provides informational, expert and financial support.

Presentation of the program "Working with

Trauma and Stress" for the Kidsave corporate team. Specialists of the Mentoring Association presented the program "Overcoming Stress, Trauma and Grief" to the Kidsave corporate team and shared the healing techniques used for children during the war in Ukraine for selfhelp in stressful situations.



As a result, the Kidsave corporate team is considering the possibility of including the block "Overcoming Stress, Trauma and Grief" in Kidsave programs when working with adoptive families.


